COMBINED LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES OF TEXAS (CLEAT) ENDORSES STATE REP. JANIE LOPEZ

AUSTIN, Texas — The Combined Law Enforcement Agencies of Texas (CLEAT) has formally endorsed Janie Lopez for re-election to the Texas House of Representatives, citing her strong support for public safety and her consistent advocacy on behalf of Texas law enforcement officers.

CLEAT's endorsement reflects confidence in Representative Lopez's leadership and her record of working alongside law enforcement to address the real-world challenges officers face on the job. During her time in the Legislature, Lopez has supported policies aimed at strengthening public safety, enhancing officer training, and reinforcing trust between law enforcement and the communities they serve.
