

Keeping *Texas* Moving

- ✓ by increasing rural highway & FM road funding by \$3B.⁴⁰
- ✓ by requiring backup power, protocols, and cost-sharing to protect ratepayers & grid.⁴¹
- ✓ by dedicating \$350M to improve dangerous railroad crossings.⁴²
- ✓ by investing \$2.9B to fund new water, wastewater & drainage projects.⁴³
- ✓ by dedicating \$368M for flood relief, prevention, response, and emergency management systems.⁴⁴
- ✓ by investing \$750M to make Texas the leader in nuclear energy.⁴⁵

Honoring *Texas* Veterans

- ✓ by creating a 100% property tax exemption for spouses of fallen veterans.⁴⁶
- ✓ by requiring better reporting to help with veteran mental health crises.⁴⁸
- ✓ by taking initial steps to professionalize the State Guard.⁴⁷
- ✓ by better placing veteran benefit advisors across the state.⁴⁹

Boosting *Texas* Schools

- ✓ by increasing state funding to House District 37 schools by +/- \$140M.⁵⁰
- ✓ by allocating +/- \$56M for House District 37 teachers to get up to an \$8k pay raise.⁵²
- ✓ by banning the use of cell phone in classrooms⁵¹
- ✓ by reinstating corporal punishment and removal for bad behavior.⁵³

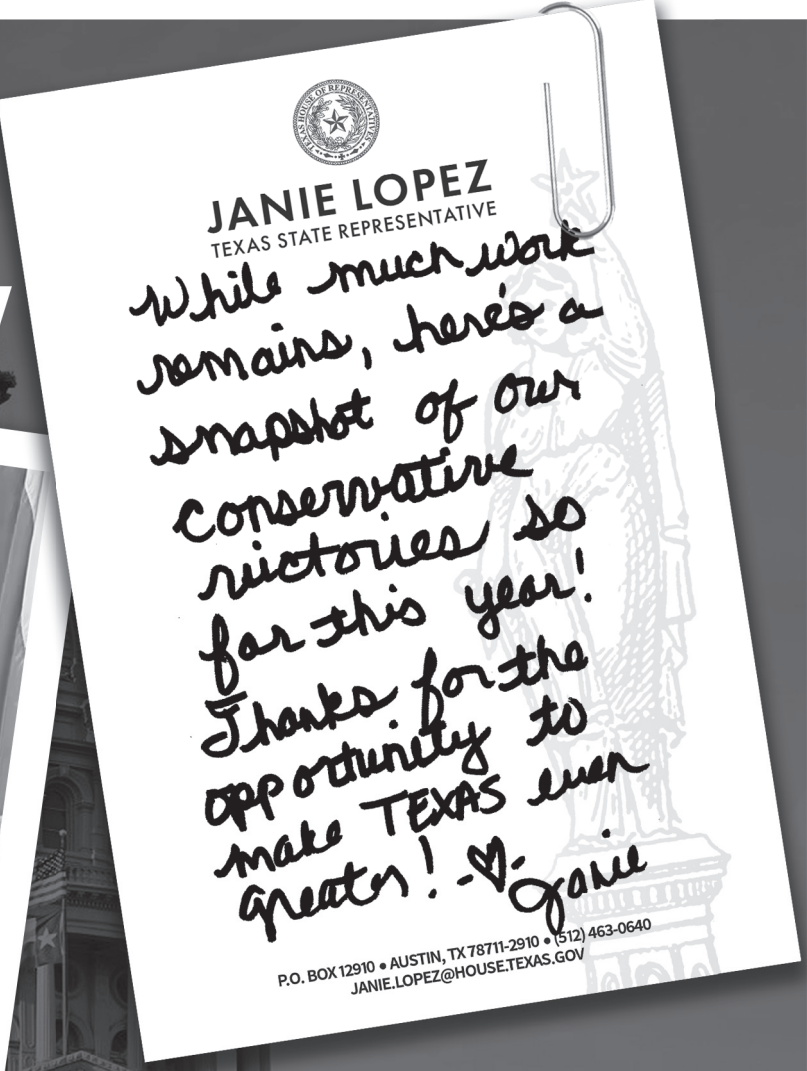
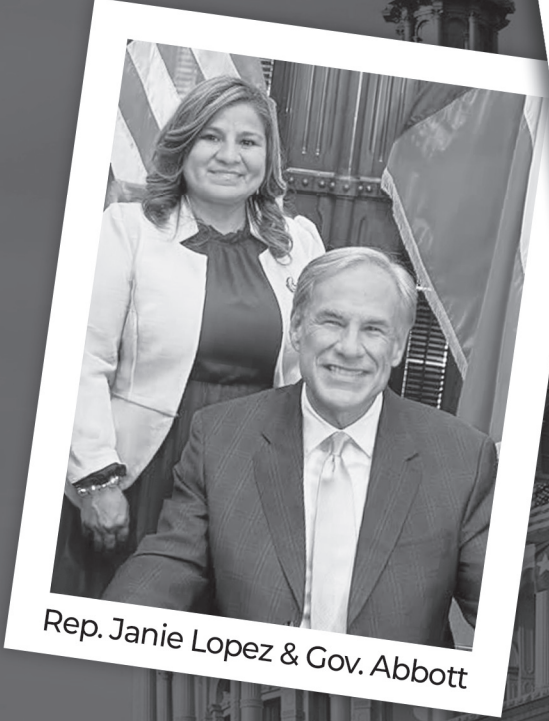

DELIVERING CONSERVATIVE RESULTS

This session, we passed measures that succeed at:

Cutting *Texas* Taxes

- ✓ by increasing the school homestead tax exemption from \$100k to \$140k.⁴
- ✓ by increasing the school homestead tax exemption to \$200k for seniors & disabled.⁷
- ✓ by prohibiting capital gains taxes & death taxes.⁵
- ✓ by prohibiting taxes on securities & securities transactions.⁸
- ✓ by increasing the business inventory tax exemption to \$125k.⁶
- ✓ by exempting border security infrastructure from property taxes.⁹

Keeping *Texas* Safe

- ✓ by requiring local law enforcement to comply with immigration laws.¹⁰
- ✓ by requiring the denial of bail to violent felony offenders.¹³
- ✓ by outlawing publicly funded gun buyback schemes.¹¹
- ✓ by outlawing China & other adversaries from buying Texas land.¹⁴
- ✓ by establishing a grant program to solve violent & sexual crimes.¹²
- ✓ by ensuring cops can use non-lethal devices without prosecution.¹⁵

Protecting *Texas* Children

- ✓ by banning DEI programs & enhancing parental control over school activities.¹⁶
- ✓ by holding schools liable for employee sexual misconduct.¹⁷
- ✓ by banning biological men from entering or using the ladies' bathroom.¹⁹
- ✓ by making child porn & human trafficking a 1st degree felony.²⁰
- ✓ by banning child-like sex dolls & artwork that sexualizes children.¹⁸
- ✓ by voiding NDA's that involve sexual abuse & human trafficking.²¹

Protecting *Texas* Values

- ✓ by requiring the display of Ten Commandments & daily time for prayer in every school.²²
- ✓ by banning the changing of gender on government documents & ID's.²⁵
- ✓ by defining in law that there are only two genders: man & woman.²³
- ✓ by banning taxpayer dollars from being used for abortion assistance.²⁶
- ✓ by strengthening parental oversight in public libraries.²⁴
- ✓ by ensuring that taxpayer dollars for health programs only go to Pro-Life orgs.²⁷

Respecting *Texas* Voters

- ✓ by enshrining in our Constitution that only citizens can vote in Texas elections.²⁸
- ✓ by cracking down on fraud & abuse during curbside voting.²⁹
- ✓ by passing the #BigBeautifulMap to increase conservative presence in Congress.³¹
- ✓ by banning quorum breaking Chairs in the Texas House.³²
- ✓ by empowering the AG to prosecute election crimes.³⁰
- ✓ by punishing quorum breakers with more severe penalties.³³

Improving *Texas* Health

- ✓ by banning food stamps from being used to purchase junk food.³⁴
- ✓ by subjecting companies that ship abortion inducing pills into Texas to \$100k lawsuits.³⁷
- ✓ by allowing Ivermectin to be bought over the counter.³⁵
- ✓ by holding vaccine manufacturers legally liable if they harm.³⁸
- ✓ by requiring informed consent before receiving a vaccination.³⁶
- ✓ by cutting red tape on food trucks & home cooked food businesses.³⁹
