- ✓ by increasing rural highway & FM road funding by \$3B.<sup>40</sup>
- ✓ by requiring backup power, protocols, and cost-sharing to protect ratepayers & grid.<sup>41</sup>
- ✓ by dedicating \$350M to improve dangerous railroad crossings.<sup>42</sup>
- ✓ by investing \$2.9B to fund new water, wastewater & drainage projects.<sup>43</sup>
- ✓ by dedicating \$368M for flood relief, prevention, response, and emergency management systems.<sup>44</sup>
- ✓ by investing \$750M to make Texas the leader in nuclear energy.<sup>45</sup>

# Honoring *Texas* Veterans

- ✓ by creating a 100% property tax exemption for spouses of fallen veterans.<sup>46</sup>
- ✓ by taking initial steps to professionalize the State Guard.<sup>47</sup>
- ✓ by requiring better reporting to help with veteran mental health crises.<sup>48</sup>
- ✓ by better placing veteran benefit advisors across the state.<sup>49</sup>

- ✓ by increasing state funding to House District 37 schools by +/- \$140M.<sup>50</sup>



# DELIVERING CONSERVATIVE RESULTS

## Cutting *Texas* Taxes

- ✓ by increasing the school homestead tax exemption from \$100k to \$140k.<sup>4</sup>
- ✓ by prohibiting capital gains taxes & death taxes.<sup>5</sup>
- ✓ by increasing the business inventory tax exemption to \$125k.<sup>6</sup>
- ✓ by increasing the school homestead tax exemption to \$200k for seniors & disabled.<sup>7</sup>
- ✓ by prohibiting taxes on securities & securities transactions.<sup>8</sup>
- ✓ by exempting border security infrastructure from property taxes.<sup>9</sup>

## Keeping *Texas* Safe

- ✓ by requiring local law enforcement to comply with immigration laws.<sup>10</sup>
- ✓ by outlawing publicly funded gun buyback schemes.<sup>11</sup>
- ✓ by establishing a grant program to solve violent & sexual crimes.<sup>12</sup>
- ✓ by requiring the denial of bail to violent felony offenders.<sup>13</sup>
- ✓ by outlawing China & other adversaries from buying Texas land.<sup>14</sup>
- ✓ by ensuring cops can use non-lethal devices without prosecution.<sup>15</sup>

This session, we passed measures that succeed at:

## Protecting *Texas* Children

- ✓ by banning DEI programs & enhancing parental control over school activities.<sup>16</sup>
- ✓ by holding schools liable for employee sexual misconduct.<sup>17</sup>
- ✓ by banning child-like sex dolls & artwork that sexualizes children.<sup>18</sup>
- ✓ by banning biological men from entering or using the ladies' bathroom.<sup>19</sup>
- ✓ by making child porn & human trafficking a 1st degree felony.<sup>20</sup>
- ✓ by voiding NDAs that involve sexual abuse & human trafficking.<sup>21</sup>

## Protecting *Texas* Values

- ✓ by requiring the display of Ten Commandments & daily time for prayer in every school.<sup>22</sup>
- ✓ by defining in law that there are only two genders: man & woman.<sup>23</sup>
- ✓ by strengthening parental oversight in public libraries.<sup>24</sup>
- ✓ by banning the changing of gender on government documents & ID's.<sup>25</sup>
- ✓ by banning taxpayer dollars from being used for abortion assistance.<sup>26</sup>
- ✓ by ensuring that taxpayer dollars for health programs only go to Pro-Life orgs.<sup>27</sup>

## Respecting *Texas* Voters

- ✓ by enshrining in our Constitution that only citizens can vote in Texas elections.<sup>28</sup>
- ✓ by cracking down on fraud & abuse during curbside voting.<sup>29</sup>
- ✓ by empowering the AG to prosecute election crimes.<sup>30</sup>
- ✓ by passing the #BigBeautifulMap to increase conservative presence in Congress.<sup>31</sup>
- ✓ by banning quorum breaking Chairs in the Texas House.<sup>32</sup>
- ✓ by punishing quorum breakers with more severe penalties.<sup>33</sup>

## Improving *Texas* Health

- ✓ by banning food stamps from being used to purchase junk food.<sup>34</sup>
- ✓ by allowing Ivermectin to be bought over the counter.<sup>35</sup>
- ✓ by requiring informed consent before receiving a vaccination.<sup>36</sup>
- ✓ by subjecting companies that ship abortion inducing pills into Texas to \$100k lawsuits.<sup>37</sup>
- ✓ by holding vaccine manufacturers legally liable if they harm.<sup>38</sup>
- ✓ by cutting red tape on food trucks & home cooked food businesses.<sup>39</sup>
